

# CODE OF CONDUCT



NMMUN'25

## **PURPOSE**

The organizations of the United Nations system are committed to enabling events in which everyone can participate in an inclusive, respectful, and safe environment. UN system events are guided by the highest ethical and professional standards, and all participants are expected to behave with integrity and respect towards all participants attending or involved with any UN system event.

The Code of Conduct applies to all participants at a UN system event, including all persons attending or involved in any capacity in the event.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR NMMUN'25**

This is a kind reminder for all participants:

1. Ensure to take care of your personal belongings, including your mobile phones, laptops, etc. The school will not be responsible for any liability in this regard.
2. In order to enhance and maintain a productive committee atmosphere, all cell phones must be on silent mode before the start of the committee. The use of Mobile Phones and Gadgets is prohibited in all non-crisis councils while the council is in session. Devices are permitted in a crisis council during the session, given that the participant does not use them for research, ONLY to communicate directives and resolutions.
3. Use of vapes, e-cigarettes, or any kind of smoking activity within the premises is strictly prohibited, those found noncompliant to the same will be expelled from the conference immediately.
4. Anyone found sick or slightly unwell is encouraged to wear a mask.
5. For maintaining the health of yourself and others it is advisable to use sanitizers available around the premises.
6. As per the rules, clicking any pictures on the school campus or /and posting them on social media without the consent of the concerned authorities is a legal offense. You are advised to refrain from doing so.
7. The Secretariat reserves the right to immediately expel delegates from the conference for unacceptable behavior including, but not limited to, vulgar language, violent behavior, inappropriate actions or derogatory comments made either in or

out of committee. Any form of harassment or offenses that hinder the inclusivity of all delegates will not be tolerated and any offenders will be dealt with immediately and strictly.

8. Delegates are bound at all times to act in accordance with good sportsmanship and in respect for fair play.
9. Parents should ensure that their child is picked up at **5:00 pm on Day 1, 24th October 2025**, and at **6:00 pm on Day 2, 25th October 2025**.

## **DRESSCODE**

Model United Nations conferences are formal meeting places for tackling serious global conflicts, and attendees are expected to reflect this with their professional and modest appearance.

All delegates, chairs, and directors are required to adhere to NMMUN's professional dress code: **Western Business Attire**. Delegates who fail to abide by the code will be asked to leave the conference and will only be allowed to return when they are in proper attire.

### **Gentlemen:**

- All participants must ensure that they are in formal attire.
- No T-shirts are allowed under the suit jacket, only formal shirts.
- Ties must not have any informal prints on them and must be tied neatly.
- Dress pants only. No jeans or shorts of any kind.
- Refrain from wearing fluorescent/ neon colors.
- No sneakers or sandals, dress shoes only.

### **Ladies:**

- All participants must ensure that they are in formal attire.
- Suits must be neat and formal and must not have informal prints of any kind.
- Informal dresses are not permitted. Formal dresses along with a blazer (optional) only.
- Kindly wear formal pants/skirts only. Skirt length must reach the knees; otherwise, you will not be allowed to enter the conference.
- Refrain from wearing fluorescent/neon colors.
- Dress pants only. No jeans or shorts of any kind.
- Dress shoes and heels are permitted. No sneakers or sandals are allowed. If the participant is wearing heels, please ensure they are comfortable.
- Makeup and Jewellery must not be too flashy.

**Note:** Chairs, Delegates, and members in **Lok Sabha** are permitted to wear **Formal Traditional Indian attire**.
